Inclement Weather — Residential and Business Recycling

Recyclables will be collected rain or shine. In the event of severe weather (e.g., a snowstorm or hurricane), recyclables will not be collected. Residents and businesses may drop recyclables off at the Borough Recycling Center (on Fairview Avenue next to the Borough Garage), or hold them until the next scheduled recycling day.


THIS SCHEDULE WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED

LEAVES MAY BE RAKED TO THE CURB AT ANY TIME FROM OCTOBER 31st THRU DECEMBER 31ST

All recyclable glass, cans, plastics, cardboard, newspapers and miscellaneous paper should be placed to the curb commingled, the night before scheduled collection day

Use a durable covered container, no larger than 45 gallons, not exceeding 50 lbs.

Do not place recyclables in plastic bags

- Aluminum, tin, and bi-metal cans used for food and beverages must be rinsed.
- Bottles and jars (soda, beer, liquor, baby food, juice, etc.) must be rinsed.
- Plastic bottles must be rinsed and flattened when possible.
- Newspapers must be clean and dry, free of plastic wrappers and tied in bundles.
- Large cardboard must be flattened and tied in bundles.
- Miscellaneous paper includes glossy papers, magazines, office paper, school papers, envelopes, junk mail, greeting cards, gift wrapping paper, chipboard (gift boxes and cereal boxes). Shredded paper is not recyclable.
- Leaves are to be raked to the curb according to 2016 Brush and Leaves Placement to Curb Schedule.
- Grass clippings no curbside collection. Additional information is available at the Borough Clerk's Office.
- Brush and limbs must be cut in 4 foot lengths or less, no more than 12 inches diameter, and placed neatly at the curb according to 2016 Brush and Leaves Placement to Curb Schedule.
- Motor oil may be deposited in the drums at the Borough Garage on Fairview Avenue.
- Button batteries can be disposed of in containers available at Borough Hall and Little Silver Public Library.
- Residents must make own arrangements for disposal of concrete, construction debris, paint, tree trunks and stumps, white goods (refrigerators, washers, dryers, stoves, etc.), scrap metal and asphalt.
- Residents must make own arrangements for disposal of computers, computer monitors and related electronics hardware, as well as analog or digital televisions. A listing of electronics recycling sites can be found at **www.littlesilver.org**.
